Students who complete an A.F.A. with a Music Emphasis at Central Piedmont Community College are exempt from lower-division General Education requirements at UNC Charlotte, including courses in composition, mathematics and logic, sciences, social sciences, and liberal studies, as well as three credits designated as writing intensive and one to three credits designated as oral communications. Students must still complete a "Writing in the Discipline" course at UNC Charlotte, as well as foreign language classes if required in their major.

Students must complete the A.F.A. with a Music Emphasis at Central Piedmont Community College in order to participate in the transfer agreement and may transfer a maximum of sixty-four (64) semester credit hours from CPCC. Students who complete an A.F.A. with a Music Emphasis at Central Piedmont Community College are exempt from all Musicianship Courses at UNC Charlotte, which includes Introduction to Music Studies; four semesters of Music Theory, Ear Training; and Piano; and two semesters of Music History.

Students who complete an A.F.A. with a Music Emphasis at Central Piedmont Community College should follow the Repertoire Guidelines for Students Auditioning for Upper-Division Study (Junior/Senior Level).

UNC Charlotte accepts a maximum of 64 semester hours of credit from two-year institutions and requires a minimum of 120 credit hours (including transfer hours) for graduation.

1. All music majors must enroll in Applied Music, a Primary Ensemble, and Performance Class every fall and spring semester they are enrolled in school. All music majors are also required to enroll in at least two Secondary Ensembles prior to graduation.

2. Required courses in music and music performance must be passed with a grade of “C” or better.

3. Students will be placed in Advanced Applied Music (MUPF 32XX) along with the co-requisite Performance Classes. Students will be advised individually following the entrance audition, and, if necessary, placed instead in lower-division Applied Music (MUPF 12XX) and the co-requisite Performance Classes. Students can still complete the program in two years with two courses in Applied Music (MUPF 12XX) and two courses in Advanced Applied Music (MUPF 32XX) with the co-requisite Performance Classes.

4. Students enrolled in MUPF 1253 (Applied Music: Voice) may be required to take MUSC 2137 (Phonetics and Articulation for Singers I) and MUSC 2138 (Phonetics and Articulation for Singers II); each is 2 credit hours and may replace Unrestricted Elective credit hours.

5. All students in UNC Charlotte’s College of Arts and Architecture must demonstrate proficiency in the language of their choice through the 1202 level. Proficiency can be demonstrated in the following ways: (1) completing the required coursework at UNC Charlotte; (2) completing three years of the same foreign language in high school through level three; (3) achieving a satisfactory score on the foreign languages placement test (in Spanish, French or German); (4) through approved transfer or transient credit earned at other accredited institutions, including Central Piedmont Community College; or (5) a combination of the above methods (e.g., placing out of or earning transfer or transient credit for 1201 and completing the 1202 course, completing 1201 and placing out of or earning transfer or transient credit for 1202).
